

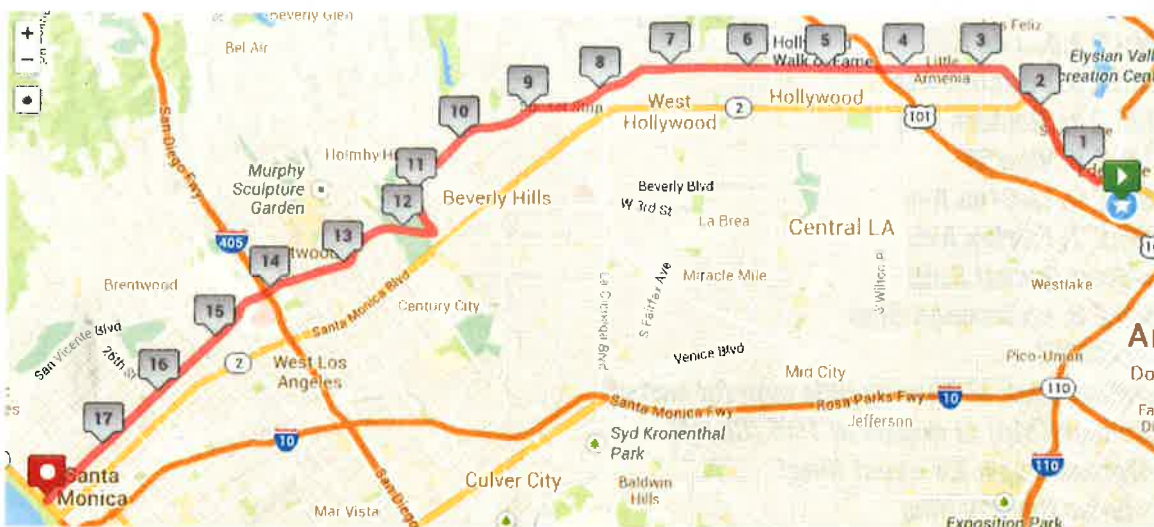

>STANDARD 24/7 (8300 Sunset Boulevard)

Hipster coffee shop.

>CARNEY'S (8351 Sunset Boulevard)

20% for GLAW walkers! Hamburgers, hot dogs, served in a vintage railcar.

>STARBUCKS (8363 Sunset Boulevard)

>HOLLYWOOD PALLADIUM / 6215 Sunset

>EARL CARROLL THEATRE (now NICKELODEON ON SUNSET) / 6230 Sunset

>CINERAMA DOME / 6360 Sunset

>AMOEBA RECORDS / 6400 Sunset

>HOLLYWOOD ATHLETIC CLUB / 6525 Sunset

>BLESSED SACRAMENT CHURCH / 6657 Sunset

>CROSSROADS OF THE WORLD / 6671 Sunset

Considered first shopping mall

>HOLLYWOOD HIGH SCHOOL / 1521 N. Highland (@ Sunset)

>CHATEAU MARMONT / 8221 Sunset

>SUNSET TOWER/ARGYLE HOTEL/ 8358 Sunset

Designed in 1929 by architect Leland A. Bryant and some still consider it one of the most important art deco structures in Los Angeles. Howard Hughes used to occupy the penthouse.

>CONTINENTAL HYATT HOUSE ("RIOT HOUSE") / 8401 Sunset

>COMEDY STORE (former CIRO'S) / 8433 Sunset

Ciros was opened in 1940 by Billy Wilkerson of the Hollywood Reporter. It was one of the hottest clubs around at the time. The Comedy Store was founded in 1972 by Mitzi Shore, who still owns the club today.

>MONDRIAN HOTEL / 8440 Sunset

The Mondrian was converted from a 1950s apartment complex to a hotel in 1984, which was styled as an homage to the Dutch painter Piet Mondrian

>77 SUNSET STRIP SHOOTING LOCATION (TIFFANY THEATRE) / 8524 Sunset

>BOOK SOUP / 8818 Sunset

Used to be the site of a mortuary, but is now one of the most popular book stores for celebrity book signings and sightings.

>VIPER ROOM / 8852 Sunset

The Melody Room, an intimate jazz bar during the 1940s, is rumored to have served as an illicit gambling den for notorious gangsters Mickey Cohen and Bugsy Siegel. In 1993, Johnny Depp transformed Central into the hip and famous Viper Room.

>WHISKY A GO GO / 8901 Sunset

>ROXY THEATRE / 9009 Sunset

Owned by Lou Adler, the Roxy has been on Sunset since 1973. Bruce Springsteen gave a breakthrough concert here in 1975.

>RAINBOW BAR & GRILL / 9015 Sunset

Joe DiMaggio and Marilyn Monroe had their first blind date here in 1953 when it was still the Villa Nova. Vincente Minelli proposed to Judy Garland at the restaurant in 1945. John Belushi ate his last meal of Lentil Soup at the Rainbow Bar & Grill before he went back to his Chateau Marmont bungalow and overdosed.

>KEY CLUB / 9039 Sunset

In the 1940s a place called Sherry's Restaurant stood here; Mickey Cohen, who was known once as Bugsy Siegel's right-hand man, was shot there in 1948. Later called Gazzari's, which gave bands like the Doors and Van Halen their starts.

>BEVERLY HILLS HOTEL / 9641 Sunset
